Bloomsday is a commemoration and celebration of the life of Irish writer James Joyce, during which the events of his novel **Ulysses** (which is set on 16 June 1904; the hero of the novel is Leopold Bloom) are relived. Since 1924 Bloomsday has been observed annually in Dublin - it is now celebrated all over the world

This second Brussels Bloomsday event will consist of brunch (Irish breakfast) together with Joyce readings and music performed by:
